As you are aware, there is an ongoing odor issue from the Blue Ridge Landfill that citizens have been dealing with since August 2015. In July 2017, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) issued an enforcement order against Republic Services' Blue Ridge Landfill (BRL) which required them, in part, to submit an Odor Control Plan to the commission for approval. Last month this plan was finally approved.

Due to the ongoing nature of this issue, my constituents have a number of questions regarding this plan and the operations at BRL. My office has coordinated a forum that I would like to invite you to attend. I have confirmed that staff from TCEQ will be present, and I'm hopeful that a representative of BRL will be there as well.
