


NOTICE OF MEETING

BRAZORIA-FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1

The Board of Directors of Brazoria-Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 1 will hold a regular meeting on Friday, November 7, 2014, at 12:00 p.m., at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200-Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, in the Sabine Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Minutes of prior meeting(s).
2. Security Services Report, including approve Security Patrol Services Agreements for additional patrol.
3. Development in the District.
4. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
5. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. design of District facilities, approval of plans and specifications, authorization to advertise for bids, award of construction contracts, and execution of any related letter financing agreements;
 - b. construction of water, sewer, and drainage facilities, including approve pay estimates, change orders and final acceptance;
 - c. inspection/maintenance of facilities;
 - d. deeds and easements and related phase I environmental assessment proposals;
 - e. impact fee payments;
 - f. bond application no. 7 and possibly add water, sewer, and drainage project to assist with development of sports park; and
 - g. storm water permitting matters.
6. Recreational facilities in and near the District, including City of Pearland's schedule for design and construction of regional sports park, clearing of leased property, installation of temporary ball fields, possible extension of lease with the City, irrigation, and additional parking.
7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, budget comparison, and amend budget.
8. Articles for newsletters and website.
9. Reports from Directors, District consultants and SCRMA regarding events and activities attended during the month.
10. Comments from the public.
11. Date, time, and location for next District meeting.
12. Discuss Municipalities Continuing Disclosure Cooperation Initiative.
13. Separation Agreement between R. Craig Rathmann and RBC Capital Markets, LLC (as successor to RBC Dain Rauscher Inc.), and Texas Attorney General settlement related thereto.
